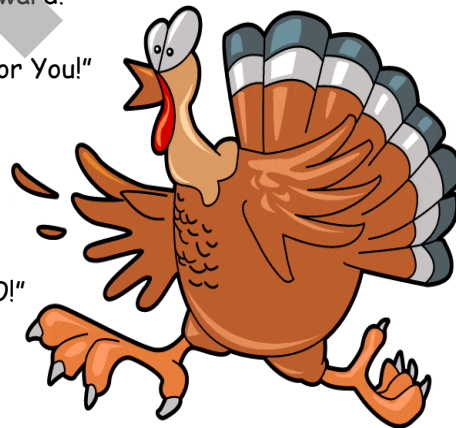

Preparing & Using the “Old Black House” Doodlebug Book:

1. It is best to have the illustrated page copied onto white cardstock. This provides stronger durability. The sentence strips can be copied onto regular copy paper.
2. Next, have students cut their sentence strips and illustration along the dotted lines.
3. Put the sentence strips back in order, one on top of the other. Staple in the rectangular box, below the illustration.
4. Students then draw what was just described in each sentence.
5. Watch children’s faces light up, as they are able to read their very own story!
